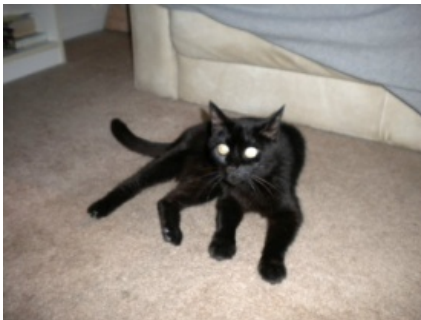
7/18/2011 - \$300.00 – Docker – Dutch Fork Animal Hospital, SC
